To help with communication concerning the races, and finalize volunteer assignments, Todd McQuade and Mary Ann Wilson (not present tonight) will present a "List of Tasks" for "Volunteer Sign-Up" concerning their respective races. These will include "Pre-race, Race, and Post-race" assignments. It was suggested to encourage local racers, to stay around Sunday night, after their races are complete, to help with tent/scoring stand/race course disassembly. This would reduce the effort needed on Monday following the races with limited volunteer help.

There is also a concern with course time available for "Vintage" racers during the National event at Quake on the Lake. Some discussions concerning two (2) heats early morning ("early"-after course is measured and set), and then the vintage boats removed from pit area, for static display in the spectator area to help promote the sport. This will also make more room for Grand Prix boats in the pit area. There was also discussion about the possibility of reducing/eliminating entry fee for vintage boats, due to limited course exposure time and/or heat cancelations. Dick Delsner will contact Mary Ann Wilson to address concerns of the Vintage Program. It was mentioned some of these concerns could have been addressed at the Regional Meeting in Perrysburg, Ohio where all concerned (both local and out-of-state) with these issues, would have been present.





