Marine Prop Riders – General Meeting – 11JA2023 – Meeting Minutes Meeting at SIMPLE PALATE called to order by Pres. John Grigg at 7:40 PM

ANNOUNCMENTS: APBA Headquarters has completed the move to Florida; the new mailing address is: American Power Boat Association, 2701 Lake Myrtle Park Rd., Auburndale, FL 33823; phone remains 586-773-9700.

December 2022 MEETING MINUTES: Motion to approve as printed in newsletter, Rich Falcinelli; second, Dave Muczinski; motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT – MARIO MARALDO: Mario Maraldo submitted the treasurer's report in person (welcome back), noting deposits totaling \$355.00 (memberships); balance is \$12,331.77. Mario noted that the APBA club membership fee is due, motion made by D. Whitney to expend \$185 for MPR to obtain a 2023 APBA club membership; second by Barry Pray; motion carried. Motion to accept Treasurer's Report, Rich Falcinelli; second Barry Pray; motion carried. Discussion ensued regarding financial review of the club treasury books (informally and probably incorrectly known as "annual audit"). Two or three members need to volunteer to review the records; motion by Steve Linn to fund provisions for the volunteers; second Tom Alfano; motion carried.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT – NANCY SPANICH: Nancy's 11JA2023 report finds: 41 primary, 15 primary family, 2 honorary, 14 lifetime, 3 lifetime family for a total of 75.

PUBLICITY - TINA WILSON: Nice job by Tina, however, not present tonight to accept allocades for the good issue.

ENTERTAINMENT – RAY DONG: Ray Dong reports (in abstentia) that having chauffered Sandy Ross to Florida, and having reached said destination and being detained by said Sandy in said destination, there will be no entertainment offered for this evening's meeting. Maybe next time.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Steve Read new race search committee: A. Belleville Lake race date is 24-25June 2023, weekend after Father's Day; seeking meeting next week with yacht club; finalize pit location, race course shape, program and any developments dealing with the city fathers. B. Ford Lake –JAYCEE's and Steve and Barrv have met with the park and DNR with success; Vic Butvila volunteered to join with them for meetings for Ford Lake. 05-06August 2023 is the target race date. C. Mott Lake's Crossroads Village (Flint area) J. Grigg extolled the many virtues of this location for racing (course size, viewing, pits, public access, proximity of hotel accommodations); Steve Read reported that initial conversations with state people are positive, next on the list are the Genesee County Sherriff and local fire department; cost to use the grounds is \$10K to the park (tough nut, but at least known!); target race date is 12-13AUGUST 2023; Steve is seeking advice on local organizational partner to continue progress; volunteer for this race committee is Dave Muczinski. D. Quake: no report.
- 2. MPR Race Committees call for members: Pres. John Grigg reported that the call to fill out committees for each of the racing endeavors being planned netted exactly no responses from the notice emailed out to members. Stepping up tonight to join committees were Steve Linn, Rich Falcinelli and Phil Goodell (Belleville). Others stepping up include Vic Butvila (Ford Lake) and Dave Musczinski (Mott Lake). Each of these proposed races need to be added to the APBA Inboard schedule and the Inboard Region 6 schedule!
- 3. Autorama: Phil Goodell reported three boats are committed to enter; up in the air is the unlimited display boat, as the Detroit City Council approval activity for racing unlimiteds on our river has not been granted to date, and the display boat will not be entered if the racing has not received that approval; the space allocated can be used by one or two additional race craft, deadline 18JA2023January. Motion by Barry Pray to spend up to \$350 for electric service for the display (to run Tina's simulator) and to cover entry costs, second Vic Butvila; motion carried. Autorama dates are 24-25-26February 2023. Mario reminded that documentation is needed for reimbursement. NEW BUSINESS:

1. APBA National Meeting news: Tim Collins (Region 6 IRC commissioner) reported on pre-meeting activities of IRC, noting several rule change proposals; of note, already passed are: 1. The radio person for a boat using the "litesaver" gadget might not have to go to the radio corral; 2. National hi-points can be awarded to boats that do not have enough boats participating on a limited basis. He indicated attendance at next month's MPR meeting to discuss the happenings at the Seattle gathering. Some discussion ensued regarding the lack of access to this year's rule change proposals. SPECIAL NOTE: as of 05JA2023, each of the 11 rule proposals for 2023 are available on the APBA website, see news.
