President's Report: No report this evening. Quake planning and preparing has occupied the President's time and focus. Get well to Ron Jones who suffered a hip fracture in an accident.

Approval of Minutes The minutes of the April meeting were published in the Newsletter and sent electronically to those requesting this format. Motion to approve by Todd M., seconded by Judy R. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: As reported by Mario Maraldo - Deposit of \$466. Disbursements of \$51.86 for postage and printing, \$50. for memorial for Doc Yinger to AMVETS, \$75 for Trailer License Plate, and \$222.60 for the display boat signage, leaving a balance of \$10,234.62.
