Dayton Testing:

The Dayton Test date is promoted and managed by the River Rats Racing Association. Mark Weber took some time to explain; who, and what, the River Rats Racing Association is all about. The whole Association is comprised of five (5) members. All are on the Board of Directors, and are lifetime Board of Directors members. They are as follows; Mark Weber (Treasurer), Billy Noonan, Ron Snyder (President), Jackie Meyer, Steve Spisak. The goal of the River Rats Racing Association is to provide a time, place, and means for Inboard Power Boat Racing. The Association members provide all up front funding, for the Dayton Test site, and hopefully are reimbursed by entry fees, and school fees on those attending. <u>APBA News</u> (Mark Weber): Dan Wiener resigned as APBA's Executive Director on April 28. Dan's resignation provided APBA with the opportunity to examine and reallocate the functions within APBA headquarters. As a result of this careful analysis, Ryan Berlin has been named Director of Operations for the American Power Boat Association; the Executive Director position will not be filled. (copied from A.P.B.A. Website)

Driving school boats are being repaired, and are on the way to their intended respective A.P.B.A. regions. Many volunteers are working hard to make this a successful program. The estate of Fred Hauenstein has donated a prop to be used on a driving school boat.

A.P.B.A. has about twenty thousand (20,000) pieces of promotional materials now printed, and are available upon request. Call Sandy Cody at the A.P.B.A. Office to receive promotional materials.

MACH News (Ray Dong): Changes are in place. MACH is looking forward to the upcoming season.

IRC Racing News (Jim Sechler): No Report

One of the "hardest to fill" volunteer positions at Quake on the Lake is; the Pit Gate Money Collector. This position is still available for anyone interested.

New Business: Mario Maraldo and Eli Whitney worked on the display boat trailer. Due to initial trailer design, repairs can only be considered marginal, at best, for long term use. Either a new trailer needs to be purchased, or a major overhaul will be required. A dolly will be needed for movement at shows, when/if, the boat, is ever repositioned to properly distribute its weight on the trailer. The club approved reimbursing Eli, one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for some of his materials used to repair the trailer. Todd McQuade will drop the trailer off at a trailer rebuilder. Mike Weber and Eli Whitney suggested the rebuilder consult with them about the special parameters required to haul Inboard Hydroplanes at an inclined plane required to get them down the road safely. Pat Sankuer and Tom Bertolini are working on the cowling.

Walled Lake Thunder Volunteer Opportunities


Walled Lake Thunder is only two weeks away, but there are still exciting opportunities available for you to be part of the action.

Member Biography


Mike Menter
