Today would have been **George English's** birthday, with good memories remaining. **Ron Jones, Sr.**'s passing was announced. A moment of silence was taken.

Membership Report – Brian Reed: 56 primary, 13 family, total 69 members. Membership cards were distributed to many attendees, others to be mailed.

**Publicity** – **Alexis Weber**: see note above, Alexis is contrite, but stuff happens and with expanded content, harder to put together and distribute! Membership indicated appreciation for efforts!

Entertainment – Ray Dong: Ray Dong announced tonight will feature an informative lecture from **Dr. Sam Fullerton**, marketing ace, this time about "Recovery Marketing", sort of a how to get back the customer you have lost in the past. This will again be pertinent info for our efforts to revive some local racing.

Race Reports - Detroit - rolling along nicely.

Quake - nothing.

Walled Lake – Jim Sechler reported an initial contact has been made, nothing newsworthy yet. Key is the infrastructure to put on race is still intact, big need is to fix the financial picture before proceeding.

Dayton Testing and APDA Driving School – on schedule for 29-30April2017.

**Evansville (Indiana)** – Labor Day weekend, Region 7 race locale, but has contracted use of the Region 6 Inboard equipment (buoys, flags, clock, etc.) and Box 21 for safety. Watch for more info as the summer goes by!

Indian Lake (Ohio) – Tony Stalder is heading up a team to produce this NEW race in Ohio 09-10SE2017; if you travel south on I-75 to Wapakoneta exit 111 (home of Neil Armstrong, 1<sup>st</sup> man on the moon), go east on US33 instead of west to Celina. Like Grand Lake St. Mary's, Indian Lake is a feeder reservoir for the old Ohio canal system. Nice looking spot for a race, and a new race at that! Point racing will be Sunday only due to the Inboard Nationals being contested in Spanaway, Washington on Saturday.

IRC news – Jim Sechler reported – New Insurance carrier (Rick Felsner's Hawk Racing); legal guardian must be at race for minor release; mentioned too many rule change proposals had to be discussed, with very few passing. Housekeeping did occur to clean up the rules here and there. Participation points are now awarded which do not require a legal start in a heat, more fair than in the past. Class combos were updated. E boats with 305 engines may race as A boats, no more 350 engines in A class. Hall of Champions point calculations also updated.

Region 6 News – Barry Pray reminded all of the APBA Region 6 Spring Meeting 18-19February2017 at the Holiday Inn French Quarter, Perrysburg, Ohio (circular in the newsletter coming out). Eli spoke of the usual facet (category) and committee meetings, plus announced a change to the awards festivities to a more informal reception featuring finger foods, cash bar, and more mingling potential, with award sessions split as in the recent past between outboard and inboard. The more formal banquet format as used in the past had become too cumbersome to manage easily, with somewhat high individual cost as a negative to attracting enough 'banqueteers'. With the more informal reception, Eli has looked to Region 6 clubs or entities for sponsorship of the reception (at the time of this meeting, already more than half of the \$1400 budget had been sponsored) so the individual cost for the reception could be reduced to \$7 per adult, kids under 16 free. A discussion ensued as to MPR joining the sponsor lineup, with a motion to do nate \$200 for the reception made by Barry Pray; second, Mario Maraldo; motion carried; Eli says THANKS!

National News: H1 (unlimited) Rookie of the Year is Andrew Tate! Atta boy!!! 2017 schedule is same as 2016, 2018 looks to add events in Guntersville, Alabama and in Arizona. At the APBA Inboard awards, the winner of the Bruce Boussard Award for dedication to inboard boat racing went to Wally Johnston, a very popular and deserving choice. Of special interest, this year was the final year of this honor in the name of Bruce Broussard; previously was known as the Bob Ballenger and Tony Scartine award, when the main plaque fills up -12 years – new plaque gets a new title name. Since the Bruce plaque is now filled, the next dozen years will find honorees being listed on the Mark Weber Award plaque, truly an honor for this lifetime MPR member.

At the Saturday evening Hall of Champions banquet, APBA Region 6 stalwart of the Mod Outboard category **Jeff Williams** was inducted into the Honor Squadron, as was inboarder **Terry Troxell** of Region 10, but well known to most of us in the MPR. KUDOS for both!

New Business: Good luck for all racing in Lakeland, Fla. 04-05MAR2017; early entry deadline coming up to get tow money.

Andy Guaresimo announced the formation of Blue Water Radio Communications, created with the purchase of Kevin Gilday's communication equipment and trailer.

# Marine Prop Riders - By-Law change proposals

#### **ARTICLE VI**

#### Section I

Club high points will be scored on a national points basis. However, in order to qualify for an award, you must attend five (5) races in Region Six or <u>four (4)</u>three (3) <u>Marine Prop Riders</u> Club meetings during a race calendar year.

\*1. Proposed revision: "....you must attend three (3) races ....."

#### Section III

To receive the annual high point award, a 500 point minimum is to be acquired.

- \*2. Proposed revision: ".....a 300 point minimum is required."
- \*3. Proposed revision: Add the following new section to the awards policy:

#### Section V

Should there not be a minimum of three (3) races within Region Six, then club high points will be determined based on the highest total national points earned.

\*4. <u>Proposed revision:</u> Renumber the following for clarification.

#### **ARTICLE VII**

#### Section I

It shall by the intent of the Marine Prop Riders to participate in the planning and race day activities of all races where it is geographically possible to do so. Each race must be considered individually and on an annual basis. The Club may only co-sponsor races by receiving a majority vote of the Board of Directors and the membership. No contract may be considered without this approval.
