## A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

**New Region 6 event at Alum Creek:** Saturday, September 19, 2009 saw the introduction of APBA Hydroplane action at this fine Ohio State Park located just north and west of Columbus, Ohio, with Vintage flybys, Hydro testing, and racing shootouts on a perfect day for boat racing. Thirty-four boats signed in, with the MPR club well represented. The event organizers hit a home run in the racers' view, and hopefully in the park's view. A race is being planned for May 2010, at this new site for Region 6 (with rumor of a second 2010 race in September!). The park setting reminds one of Stony Creek and Pontiac Lake, very pleasant. It is easy to reach, being just off US23 a few miles south of Delaware, Ohio. It's Buckeye country, as Mark Weber found out, with the only headgear available to him being a red and silver baseball cap with a big OSU quite visible to all!

The non-point shootouts were organized by combining boat classes of similar size and speed: Group 1 – T, Y, S; Group 2 – A, E; Group 3 NM, GNH, GP. Two heats were run for each group, with finishing positions overall determining trophy awards (top three in each group).

Nice participation plaques were awarded to the 14 Vintage attendees. Box 21 provided the rescue services (unneeded this day!), Mark Weber, Steve Spisak, Ron Snyder, Bill Noonan, and Jack Meyer populated the judges stand, Rich Evans kept a watchful eye on tech specs, Todd McQuade doing whatever, and Sam Anspach (with help from Rachel) kept the crane busy. The host committee was led by Mike Hicks from Columbus, Ohio, kudos to all involved!

It must be said here, this event has been in a wishing and planning stage for about four years. Matt (a member of Jimmy Deel's crew) wrote out a proposal for a boat race at Alum Creek for his English class that year (term paper); a little while later, Mike Hicks came to a Region 6 Spring Meeting with a pitch and photos; since all that, it has finally happened. In a similar manner to how MPR and Racer Bob got Stony Creek jump started with a test session, we hope we see history repeating at Alum Creek!

**MPR Banquet:** As announced already, it is coming up in November, six weeks away. We will honor all the club trophy winners, both racing class winners and the special trophies, culminating in the prestigious Prop Rider of the Year. New this year: location (**Concorde Inn, Mt Clemens, Mich**); back to Saturday night (**November 14, 2009**); cost almost cut in half (**\$25 per person**); cash bar. Let's boost attendance and show interest as we honor our victors. Menu is selected, we will be dining in a buffet setting on a selection of salads and condiments, farfalla marinara, chicken piccata and roasted pork tenderloin, California mixed veggies, and red skin potatoes, with coffee, tea and soft drinks provided. Ten round seating is planned, you can reserve a whole table by contacting Mario. Whether we realize this or not, this banquet setting provides credibility to our awards and our efforts, we need to support the event like it was a race.

**Volunteers:** While in danger of sounding like a broken record, please read Judy Roberts' article about volunteering for MPR. Think about it some, and try to step up. Not everything one volunteers for is work, it is often fun and worthwhile. We, as a club, need to support our races, which is part of the club's reason for being. We need to live up to our purpose.
