Marine Prop Riders – General Meeting – September 1st 2010 – Meeting Minutes

Meeting: at Crash Landing, Madison Heights. Called to order by Eli Whitney at 7:52 P.M. 50-50 drawing this month conducted by Cady Reiss and Charley Wilson.

General announcements: Eli emphasized the importance of voting for nominees running for election to the **APBA** Board of Directors. There are many good people running this year; make your best 4 selections out of the 9 individuals running. Eli also noted that Paul Poledink's newly restored vintage hydro White Lightning CE 52 won "Best Hydroplane" at the Toledo Antique and Classic Boat Show on Aug 28-29. Competition included Miss US 1 and Such Crust IV.

Approval of Minutes: of Aug 4, 2010 General Meeting. Motion to approve by Judy Roberts, seconded by Red Mathis. No discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Mario Maraldo reported the **August** financial activities as \$44.99 for stamps and \$147.80 printing, leaving a balance of \$11,519.93. Motion to approve by Ray Dong, seconded by Bob Wilson. No discussion; unanimous approval.

Membership Report: Membership stands at 100+ as reported by Cadi Reiss. New members include Kevin Lacey and David Gemmel, who are interested in the 5 Liter Class.

Publicity: Brian Reed continues the cleanup of the web site, but also re-emphasized the need for more content providers for the newsletter. Suggestions and input are sorely needed.

Entertainment: Ray Dong announced that Sandy Ross will again show blasts from the past after the meeting, including Walled Lake Thunder highlights, old limited hydro racers, Gale racing memories and other assorted racing topics.

Race Reports

Waterford/ Quake on the Lake MaryAnne Wilson reported that the Quake this year was in reality a preparation for the "Quake" hosting the 2011 Summer Nationals. Racing will be a two day affair, Saturday and Sunday. Meetings are already being held to review the excellent, the pretty good and the not so hot of the 2010 Quake. A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

October – color time in the forests of Region 6. It also marks the ending of the race season for inboard hydros in Region 6, as the finals at Rocky Fork are in the books (Alum Creek having postponed until next year). While the racing has ended, and MACH championships decided, there still remains some club and region activity: meetings and elections.

First, though, a couple other newsworthy items.

OPC racer Dan Schwartz continues to be hospitalized with serious injuries resultant from a racing incident at the OPC Nationals in Kankakee, Ill. The APBA website News page has some info on a support effort for Dan and his family. Support messages can also be sent via www.CaringBridge.org, look for Dan Schwartz if you care to offer encouragements, the club has already done so. This type of support works, as many of us already know. On our own front, Nick Broggi, father of Steve Broggi, one of Mario Maraldo's long time crewmembers, passed away 27SE10. Our condolences go out to Steve and his family.

Secondly, APBA BOD election news: The four elected are Mark Wheeler, R. Steven Hearn, Chris Fairchild, and Dan Kanfoush. Full results are elsewhere in this issue or can be found on the APBA website news page.

The Marine Prop Rider annual elections of officers will occur at the October 6 regular monthly meeting at Crash Landing. Nominations were opened in September for positions on the club BOD, these will be reopened at the October meeting, then closed, immediately followed by the elections (club members present get to vote). Nominated already: President – Eli Whitney; Vice President – Eric Pomber; Treasurer – Mario Maraldo; Secretary – Paul Poledink; Publicity Director – Brian Reed; Entertainment Director – Ray Dong; Members at Large – Mary Anne Wilson, John Grigg; Membership Director is open right now, no one has stepped up or accepted nomination. Last October, Cadi Reiss volunteered to serve in this position for a year and the year is up, it is someone else's turn. Prop Riders, be at the October meeting and participate in this important meeting and vote! The newly elected officers take up their posts November 1st.

What else is in store in the near future for the Prop Riders? Why, the annual MPR Awards Banquet, again being held at the Concorde Inn (Mt. Clemens, Michigan), Saturday evening, November 13, 2010. Same place, same price (if at all possible – last year we cut the cost almost in half to the \$25 range), same time (6 pm cocktails, 7 pm eats, 8 pm or thereabouts awards). This event is a great time and deserves attending, as the club champions are recognized. All are welcome, you do not have to be a club member, just be there and enjoy. I mentioned region activity: the Region 6 Fall Meeting, October 23-24, 2010, Holiday Inn French Quarter, Perrysburg, Ohio, 419-874-3111, www.hifq.com, exit 193 off I-75 (a mile south of the Ohio Turnpike interchange). Fall brings region elections, not only in the various committees within the region, but also for each category. Positions filled are not only regional, but have national impact as the various categories elect commissioners for the respective APBA category racing commissions. Region 6 Inboard will elect two commissioners for the Inboard Racing Commission (the national governance group for Inboard), currently serving are Mario Maraldo and Jim Sechler; as a note, the number of commissioners for a region is dependent on various factors, including number of members and number of regattas. Region 6 Inboard also will elect Region officers: Chairman and Director (currently Billy Noonan and Steve Spisak, respectively, and as a note, both are Prop Riders); the newly elected chairman then appoints an Alternate Director, thusly forming a three person BOD for Inboard. From each of the standing committees (Officiating, Club) and categories, the respective Chairman and Director positions form the Region 6 Board of Directors, which is the governing group for the region. Various meetings as usual will be scheduled by Tom Johnston, Region 6 Chairman, including a technical seminar, Inboard Race Chairman's, Inboard Officiating, Region 6 Officiating, Club, along with each category; look for the circular either on the APBA website or in this newsletter. Inboard additionally has a bylaw change vote scheduled for Sunday morning's meeting, adding to the importance of this meeting.

Saturday evening has no scheduled happenings, but the host hotel's accommodations are primo (restaurant and the bar has regular entertainment), along with plenty of alternative food choices in the immediate area. Dunk tests (capsule training) for restrained drivers is offered by Box 21 Saturday morning only starting at 7:30AM at the hotel pool, donation of \$30 accepted (not on Sunday, economic factors preclude the second day). For those who come Saturday morning but have nothing planned for Saturday afternoon, well, take a drive east on the Turnpike or US-20 to Fre-

mont, Ohio, where a really good racing equipment swap meet is scheduled at the Sandusky County Fairgrounds (US Route 20 and Ohio Route 53). Trust me, racers of all sorts can find something there of interest, you can learn about recycling your old parts if nothing else. Check it out on www.fremontohspeedway.com, I go when I can and have recycled a lot of my old stuff there!

August 28th, Cadi and I pointed the GNH-515 One Way south to Celina, Ohio for the Regatta Musicfest. It was a great time, nearly \$9500 was raised for Grand Lake St. Marys rehabilitation efforts. Attendance was great, we joined several other boats representing all sizes of inboard hydros (Tony Black's A-41 Jamikin Me Crazy, Chreyl and Mike Bruns E-6 Quantum Leap, vintage E-4 Sir Ron, and the U-1 Unlimited from Formula Boats) which participate at the annual Ohio Governor's Cup at Celina. Next year (2011) is the Worlds Championships for Celina, Myron Buxton, Allen Baskett and team are already working towards that event. This event has close ties to MPR, and is deserving of support.

That same weekend, August 28-29, Paul Poledink exhibited his vintage CE-24 White Lightning at the Toledo Antique Boat Show, resulting in winning "Best Hydro" at the show. The show site is to be the new marine museum in Toledo, located on Front Street on the Maumee River, just upstream from the new I-280 bridge. Paul had a great time helping to promote APBA racing, Marine Prop Riders, and vintage activities. This show is an annual event, expecting to use this new site to their advantage.

Another big event for 2011 is the 12th annual Quake on the Lake in Waterford, Michigan, which will host the APBA Inboard Nationals. Mary Anne Wilson and her team is working hard right now to make their mark on that event. First time for the Nationals in Michigan since the Ford Lake days (1970?)! If they ask you to do something, be honored, pitch in and do it, it is not work, it is to be part of a great event.

Rocky Fork 2010: great racing, great field of boats. At least one record was set, a couple others nearly broken as the weather and water conditions were conducive to speed and competition. North American Championships were awarded and include Prop Riders Steve Kuhr (GNH), Royce Richards and George English (A), and Jim Sechler (Y). Congratulations to all class winners and MACH champions! How big was the field? Check this out: elimination heats in T, S, E, A, NM, and GNH; four GP's, yes, Grand Prix, supercharged excitement on the big lake, with a record barely missed on Saturday and Sunday! Competitors came from as places like Quebec and Ontario, Canada; Florida; Minnesota; Virginia; Pennsylvania; New York; Delaware; New Jersey; Maryland; Georgia; Massachusetts; and Louisiana, along with the Region 6 and Region 7 states of Michigan, Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana, and Illinois).

Enough already, plenty of news in the newsletter, come to the October meeting and vote! eli
